VANDAL X – Hand Painted Boots and Shoes 2015

Welcome to Vandal X. I am offering special pricing through June 2015 to celebrate the launch of my unique, one-of-a-kind footwear. Four pairs a month will be produced during this period. 10% of the purchase price will be donated to charitable organizations. The following prices and terms are valid for the first 24 pairs of Vandal X product.

"Blue Dream 003p"

- Shoes up to 5 eyelets (or three buckles) are **\$550.00**, plus the retail cost for the shoes.
- Boots are \$850.00 up to 14 eyelets. Taller boots will be priced on an individual basis.
- Any style that doesn't fit into the above parameters will be priced on an individual basis (e.g. mid-ankle boot with wedge heel, etc.).
- After initial consultation with client, shoes/boots are ordered and production time is two weeks from the time I receive the shoes at my studio. Client downpayment is due at this time, and is equal to the retail cost of the shoes. If for any reason the order is cancelled after work has begun, client is billed for the full amount.
- Vintage, pre-worn, or used footwear is not accepted for design services. Many shoes have dirt, grime, wax, etc. that will interfere with my process. If there is a pair that has special sentimental value, I might be able to accommodate this type of request. This will be determined on a case-by-case basis. A consultation fee of \$75.00 will be applied to the final cost of the shoes.
- The shoes/boots I have selected to "Vandalize" are limited to certain Dr. Marten styles. This may change as I explore other options, but Docs are well-built, comfortable and evoke a fringe lifestyle that suits my sense of connection to the medium. I'm considering several other brands at the moment, and I'll update with newly added styles as they become available. We can discuss your selection during our initial consultation.
- Suede, canvas, heavily textured leather and other surfaces are not appropriate for this type of detailed art. If you really want my shoes in that material, I can produce a small swatch to demonstrate how the final product will appear. These materials are NOT recommended. (continued)



Walk With Art.

- You are buying a work of art. The shoes are my canvas. Each pair, indeed, each shoe is different. I paint, draw, etch, etc., directly on each shoe individually. No stencils, no pre-made patterns, no production line. Two weeks is my *minimum* production time, and is based on your place in the queue. During this introductory period, I will produce four pairs a month. Orders will be accepted beyond that number, but delivery is not guaranteed in that two week time frame if the monthly quota has been reached. Each month four spots will open up, and it will be first come, first served in order of receipt of down payment. If an order is cancelled, that spot opens back up, and the corresponding number is applied to the next in line.
- These are shoes. And art. You can choose to display them, or wear them with pride and the knowledge that no one else on the planet has these shoes. I use permanent inks/paints and each pair is clear coated four times to ensure a durable finish. That said, it's still a shoe, vulnerable to the elements. I make no claims that you can't scratch, scuff, damage or maim the art under those conditions. Shoes have stress points where creases naturally appear as you break them in. This might affect the detail at those areas over time. If you park your Ferrari in enough parking lots, it will get scratched.
